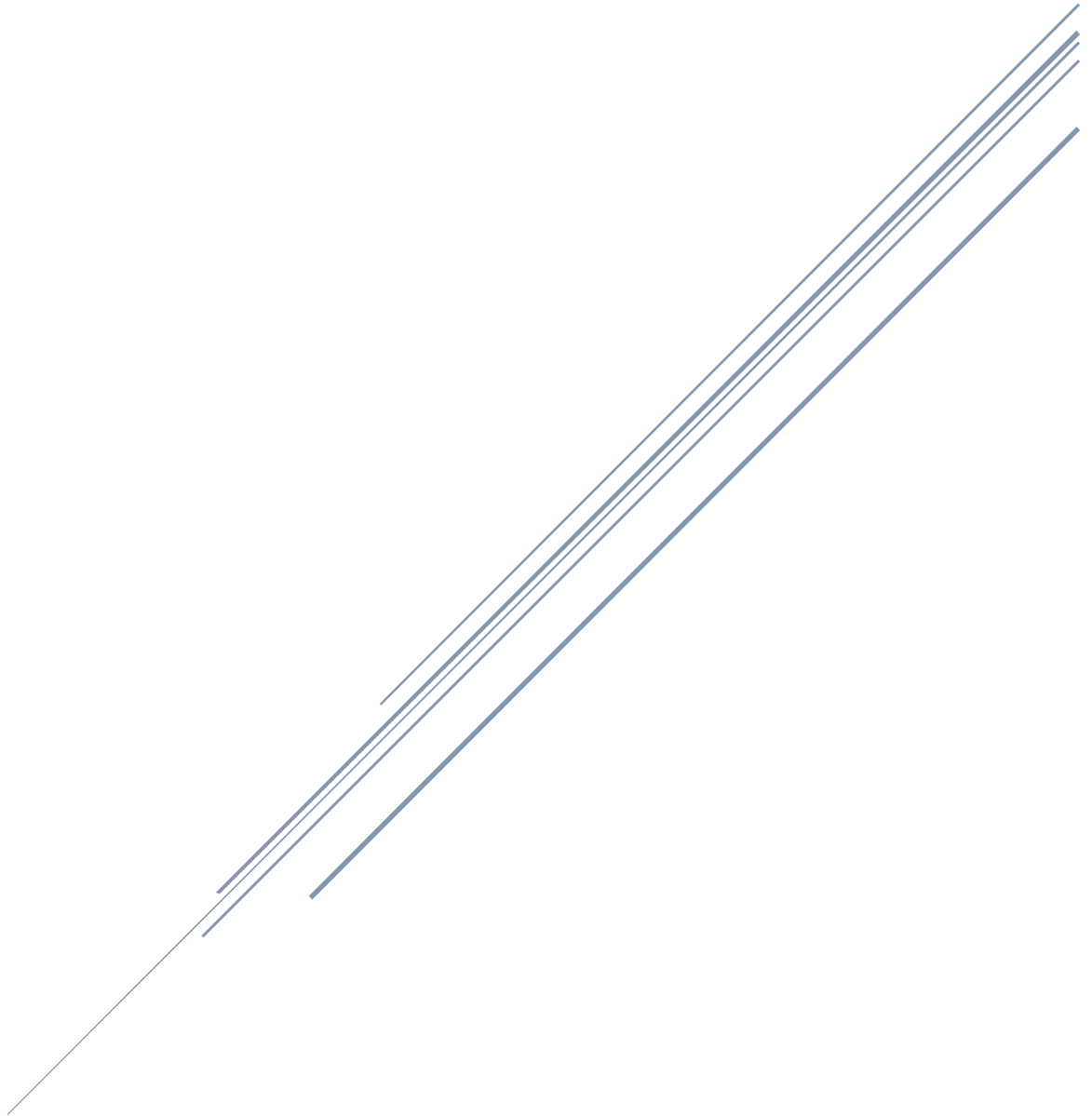

Pandoc Document Conversion

1. Introduction

Pandoc is a document conversion tool that allows you to convert documents from one format to another effectively.

This user manual will guide you through the process of converting a document from Microsoft Word (.docx) to Markdown (.md).

2. Getting Started

Before you begin, make sure you have:


- **Pandoc installed** on Windows (best to download from [GitHub](#)).
- A Microsoft **Word (.docx) document** that you want to convert.
- Basic **command line interface** knowledge.

3. PowerShell Console

To perform this conversion, open PowerShell console and navigate to the directory where your .docx file is located.

In our example, it is *Downloads* file.

Type ***cd – space – Downloads***:



5. The Command

Now, use the following command: ***pandoc input.docx -o output.md***.

Replace ***input.docx*** with the actual name of your .docx file and ***output.md*** with the desired name for your Markdown file.

In our example: ***pandoc conversion.docx -o conversion.md***:

PS C:\Users\mirja> cd Downloads
PS C:\Users\mirja\Downloads> pandoc conversion.docx -o conversion.md
```

Press *Enter*. The conversion is executed, check the markdown file.

6. Troubleshooting

The most common issues you may encounter during conversion:

1. The location of the file is wrong. Check the navigation to the directory (folder) where the file is located.
2. The format of the Word document is wrong. Make sure the Word extension is .docx. If not, first convert the file to .docx, and then to .md. (Pandoc does not recognize the .doc extension.)

11. Conclusion

Pandoc significantly simplifies the process of converting files from .docx to .md extension. When there is a need to convert tens or even hundreds of documents, it is good to know there is a tool which can do most of the work.
