New Features

Expanded Language Support

- Added support for Russian, Japanese, and Arabic languages

Performance Improvements

Faster Speech Recognition

- Optimized the Speech Recognition Engine for faster and more accurate transcriptions of voice commands
- Reduced latency and improved responsiveness when using voice commands

Enhanced Natural Language Understanding

- Fine-tuned the Natural Language Processing (NLP) Module to better understand user intent and extract relevant information
- Resulted in more accurate execution of voice commands and reduced the need for users to repeat or rephrase requests

Bug Fixes

Resolved Attachment Issue

- Fixed a bug that occasionally prevented users from attaching files from Google Drive using voice commands
- Users can now seamlessly attach files by speaking the file name or describing the file
